

Minibus travel policy.

Aim: to ensure pupils and driver travel in a safe environment to and from school

- Pupils must sit down, put on a seat belt, and stay sitting down from start to finish, unless given instructions from the driver.
- All instructions from the driver will be heeded and obeyed.
- Pupils must behave sensibly, and not upset others, either verbally or physically.
- Pupils will keep heads and limbs inside the bus when it is in motion.
- Pupils will not lean out of windows, throw any object out of the bus, throw any object inside the bus or shout to pedestrians.
- Pupils should report problems encountered to the driver, parent or teacher as soon as possible.
- Litter will not be left on the bus.
- Graffiti will not be written anywhere on the bus and seats will not be damaged in any way.
- If any pupil is concerned about safety or behaviour on the bus, the pupil, or parent should contact the Vice Principal.
