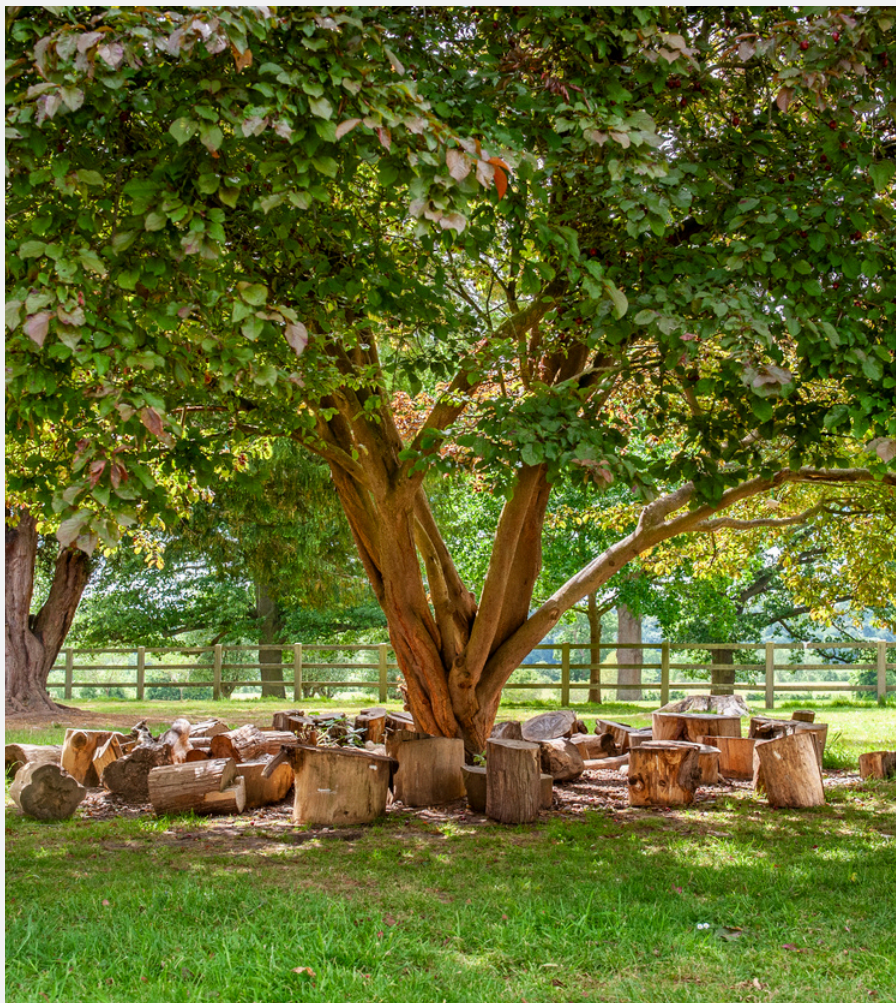

Parents receive a link by email, while students can also check the department noticeboard or hear details from their teachers. Please be aware that last-minute changes do happen and final selections may not be confirmed until the day before. For this reason, we encourage parents and students to check the website the day prior to each fixture.

Sports Kit

All Bredon sports kit is supplied by Stevensons and should be ordered in good time so that students are fully equipped from the start of term. The correct kit must be worn for all lessons, training and fixtures.

- Core kit is compulsory for games, PE, outdoor education and clubs.
- Optional items may be needed depending on sports chosen.
- Students who take part in daily activities may find extra kit useful to keep on top of washing.

Students are expected to change into kit for every lesson or training session, even if they are unwell or injured, so that staff can adapt activities accordingly. If a student cannot participate fully, parents or boarding staff should notify David Hughes and the Health Centre.

If a student repeatedly arrives without the correct kit, parents will be contacted, and persistent issues will be managed in line with the school's behaviour policy.

School Rules

Our rules are in place to make Bredon a safe, respectful and supportive community where everyone can learn and thrive. They help create a sense of security, protect people and property, and make clear what behaviour is acceptable.

We ask parents to read the School Rules with their children and to support us in ensuring they are followed. This partnership helps maintain the positive environment that benefits all students.

The rules apply:

- In school and on school trips (including educational visits and sporting fixtures)
- When travelling to and from school
- Whenever students are wearing the Bredon uniform

Unacceptable behaviour disrupts learning, affects the safety and wellbeing of others and will be addressed in line with school sanctions.

The rules are as follows:

Respect & Conduct

- Treat all members of the School community, visitors and the public with courtesy and respect.

School Rules

- Bullying in any form, including cyberbullying, is forbidden (see Anti-Bullying Policy).
- Any action that could bring the School's name into disrepute (verbally, in print or online) is not acceptable.
- Contact with the media on behalf of Bredon School is not permitted without approval from the School.

School Life & Responsibilities

- Attend School and all timetabled activities punctually and regularly. Permission from the Headmaster is required for absence (except in the case of sudden illness).
- Be committed to both academic work and extracurricular activities.
- Wear the correct School uniform at all times, following the uniform dress code.
- Sixth Form students may bring cars only with written permission from the Headmaster and Head of Sixth Form and with all paperwork completed.
- Take pride in the School environment: use bins for litter, care for property and report any damage immediately. Students are responsible for paying for any damage caused.
- Students must not order deliveries to School without staff permission.
- Chewing gum and spitting are not permitted anywhere on site.

Safety, Behaviour & Integrity

- Adhere to the School ICT Acceptable Use Policy at all times.
- Gambling, buying or selling on site is not allowed.
- Possession or use of tobacco, illegal drugs, legal highs, e-cigarettes/vapes or alcohol is forbidden. Students aged 18+ may only consume alcohol in moderation on appropriate occasions under staff supervision. Breaches will lead to parents being informed and likely temporary exclusion.
- Stealing is strictly forbidden.
